

Amendment to Copper Creek Homes Association Declaration of Restrictions

The following text was approved by a majority vote of the Copper Creek Homes Association at the April 2004 homes association meeting regarding a change in the Building Material Requirements, specifically roofing materials.

Approval of a change in the Copper Creek Declaration of Restrictions for Lots 1 through 19, Block 1; Lots 1 through 11, Block 2; Lots 1 through 18, Block 4; Lots 1 through 4 and Lots 11 through 15, Block 8 Copper Creek, 1st Plat and Lots 6 through 10, Block 8, Copper Creek, 3rd Plat, and Lot 5, Block 8, Copper Creek 2nd Plat, and Lots 1 through 16, block 3; Lots 19 through 23, Block 4, Copper Creek, 4th Plat and Lots 20, 21, 22, Block 1; Lots 12 through 22, Block 2, Lots 1 through 11, Block 3 Copper Creek 6th Plat, a subdivision in the City of Olathe, Johnson County, Kansas on page 3, paragraph 3. Building Material Requirements whereas the following portion will be revised:

From *“Roofs with a pitch of three inches or more per foot shall be covered with wood shingles, wood shakes, or slate”*

To *“Roofs with a pitch of three inches or more per foot shall be covered with wood shingles. wood shakes. slate, or 40 year shadow tone, 'weathered wood' color asphalt composition shingles. The color and pattern must match existing roofs in the development and be approved by the Architectural Committee.”*
